Due to the upcoming changes concerning the protection of privacy, taking into consideration the effective entry into force of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: "GDPR") and in particular Article 13 GDPR, we would like to provide you with the following information.

Data Controller.

Your data Controller is **Towarzystwo Funduszy Inwestycyjnych Capital Partners S.A.** (hereinafter: the "Company") with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. Królewska 16, 00-103 Warsaw, registered by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000258883, statistical number REGON: 140606412, tax identification number NIP: 7010027837.

Contact with the Controller.

The Controller has appointed the Data Protection Officer, whom you may contact by e-mail: iod-tfi@c-p.pl or letter addressed to: ul. Królewska 16, 00-103 Warsaw. The Data Protection Officer may be contacted in all matters concerning the processing of personal data and exercising the rights related to the processing of data.

Processing of your data lets the Company render services, among other things, provide information on our Company.

Legal basis of the processing of data and the purpose of the processing.

The legal basis of the processing of your data is as follows:

1. Art. 6.1a) GDPR, i.e., prior granting of your consent for the processing of your personal data,
2. Art. 6.2 f) GDPR, i.e., processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller; among other things provision of information on the objects, its products or services.-

Categories of relevant personal data.

The Company processes the following ordinary personal data, i.e.: name and surname, correspondence address, email address, telephone number, for the afore-mentioned purposes.

The Company does not process other personal data for the afore-mentioned purposes.

Processing of personal data in the Company.

Your personal data will be processed in the IT environment, which means that the data may also be temporarily stored and processed to ensure safety and proper functioning of IT systems, for instance in relation to the production of backup copies, revealing of irregularities or protection against abuses and attacks.

Your personal data may also be transferred to entities processing personal data at a commission of the Controller in the scope that is necessary to render services, i.e., to IT service suppliers, post operators and couriers.

Data storage period.

In the scope in which the basis for the processing constitutes your consent, the data will be processed by the time it is withdrawn. You may withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing conducted before its withdrawal. If you wish to withdraw your consent for

the processing of your data, please send an e-mail or letter to the address indicated in the section “contact with the Controller” above.

Information on the automated decision-making.

The Company makes automated decisions whilst processing your personal data relying exclusively on the automated processing of personal data, including profiling.

Information on the intention to transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization:

The Company does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or an international organization.

Rights of data subjects.

Please be informed that you provide your personal data voluntarily and that you have the following rights related to the processing of your personal data by the Company:

1. right to demand access to your personal data from the controller;
2. right to correct the data;
3. right to remove the data;
4. right to restrict the processing;
5. right to object to the processing of your data,
6. right to transfer the data (if technically possible),
7. right to file a complaint with a personal data supervisory body (now the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection).

Complaints.

Moreover, you are authorized to file a complaint with a supervisory authority dealing with the protection of personal data in the member state of your ordinary stay, workplace or place where the alleged breach has occurred.

Final information.

We would like to assure you that the Company undertakes any effort to provide physical, technical and organisational means to protect personal data against accidental or intentional destruction, accidental loss, change, unauthorized disclosure, use or access in compliance with all applicable provisions of law. We are open to your suggestions as regards the improvement of the safety of personal data. Please address them using the contact details of the Data Protection Officer indicated above.
